

**MINUTES – SPECIAL MEETING
BOONE TOWN COUNCIL
MARCH 30, 2026**

CALL TO ORDER

A special meeting of the Boone Town Council was called to order on Monday, March 30, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. at the Police Department located at 1500 Blowing Rock Road in Boone. Mayor Dalton George presided. Town Council members present included Mayor Pro-Tem Todd Carter, Virginia Roseman, Adrian Tait, and Anne Pruitt. Town Staff present included Interim Town Manager/Human Resources Director Dale Presnell and Town Clerk Nicole Harmon. The purpose of the meeting was to allow members to tour various Town facilities and meet staff.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Council members toured the Police Department and listened to a brief history of the building given by Police Chief Daniel Duckworth and Assistant Chief Shane Robbins. Space needs and necessary upgrades to the camera system were noted.

WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Council members toured the Ricky L. Miller Water Treatment Plant located on Deck Hill Road. Water Treatment Plant Superintendent Jody Prevette noted that a filter and tank at the facility are in need of replacement.

FIRE STATION TWO

Fire Chief Jimmy Isaacs and Division Chief of Operations Kent Brown provided a tour of Fire Station Two on State Farm Road. They noted that the facility, constructed in 1985 specifically for fire service operations, has been maintained and updated as needed over time. Staff indicated plans to relocate the trailers currently stored in the rear parking lot to Fire Station Four upon its completion. Chief Isaacs also highlighted ongoing concerns related to cut-through pedestrian traffic from adjacent parks, which can create conflicts with Fire Department vehicle operations.

Mayor George declared a break at 12:00 p.m. The meeting reconvened at 1:00 p.m.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

Council members toured the Jimmy Smith Wastewater Treatment Plant located on Casey Lane. Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent Rudy Broschinski provided a tour of the grounds, and Lab Supervisor Karen Reece provided a tour of the lab facility.

FIRE STATION THREE

Council members toured Fire Station Three, located on Bamboo Road. Fire Chief Jimmy Isaacs provided a brief history of the property, noting that it had originally been a residential property that was later converted into a functioning fire station.

With no objection, Mayor George adjourned the meeting at 3:11 p.m.
